### What training needs to be completed after the Investigator Meeting?

The Investigator Meeting (IM) will serve as Protocol Training, Study Coordinator Training and Pharmacy Training for all attendees. The MOST team, on the behalf of our attendees, will reconcile training requirements in WebDCU<sup>TM</sup> after the IM.

Between the Investigator Meeting and the time study drug becomes available, sites should solidify their local logistics, train their teams, and complete Readiness Calls.

# Is my Conflict of Interest (COI) form expired?

The MOST prime protocol received initial CIRB approval on 4/24/2018. The continuing review was completed early, in January of 2019, so it would not interfere with the CIRB's ability to approve new sites. The date of COI expiration is now 1/27/2020. The central team will extend the expiration dates in WebDCU<sup>TM</sup> so individuals do NOT need to upload new COIs.
