RCT Participation at a Non-Academic Stroke Practice

- All members of the stroke team are co-investigators
- Morning pre-rounds with the stroke team
 - Identify all cryptogenic (ESUS) patients
 - Review inclusion/exclusion
 - Communicate with our coordinators (immediately available to help!)
 - Consent while inpatient determine if we will complete screening while in hospital or in clinic (almost all of our patients were consented in the hospital)

RCT Participation at a Non-Academic Stroke Practice

- Patients are not used to being screened for trials (or "experiments") while hospitalized at a non-academic hospital
 - Be explicit about standard of care
 - Minimize therapeutic misconception
 - Be clear of conflicts of interest
 - Be thorough of potential benefits, risks, and alternatives
- Enroll consistently!
 - Vigilant team
 - PI helps screen patients weekly
