Introduction

The 11th Annual Acute Stroke Management Conference is designed to provide the most recent advances in stroke care for nurses and health care providers including physical, occupational, and speech therapists. This event is held annually to assist with educational requirements of nurses who work at TJC stroke certified centers and to provide education to health care professionals who care for stroke patients.

Objectives

- List the inclusion/exclusion criteria for ischemic stroke patients eligible for endovascular treatment
- Specify the different levels of stroke certification and interactions within a stroke system of care
- Review incidence and treatment of seizure in the stroke patient
- Explain the importance of temperature management in the stroke patient
- Describe the current Primary Stroke Center (PSC) certification criteria and onsite review process
- Summarize the NIH Stroke Scale, modified Rankin Score (mRS) and outcome metrics used in quality assessment of stroke
- Integrate clinical information and daily practice through clinical case review
- Discuss the rationale and use of palliative care in the stroke patient
