




Pearls of WISDC

Advice and Suggestions





Visit 1, Visit 2 and Visit 3 assessments can all be completed on the same day as long as each assessment is completed within its respective window



Eligible participants do **not** need to be functionally independent pre-stroke

Even if they needed assistance to take care of themself prior to the current stroke, if they didn't have limitations in the use of their stroke-affected arm previously and can consent for themselves, then they are eligible



Identify potentially eligible patients within the first 24 hours of onset



Remember to re-screen patients at later times during hospitalization

Even if patients don't initially qualify, they may qualify later (after 1-2 days)



Schedule Day 90 Visit at the start of the visit window (i.e., Day 76, or two weeks prior to Day 90)

Allows for more wiggle room if something unexpected comes up



We strongly recommend installing the MEGA-TMS software onto a second computer in case of issues. This only applies to sites with a laptop supplied with the MEGA-TMS machine.

- TMS Tips: When you finish a TMS session and save the data, please immediately reopen and check to see if the data look correct. If the data didn't save correctly, then you can quickly re-test the patient as they are still present and prepped for TMS.
